State Fund Offers **Extended Credit** to Policyholders Affected by California Wildfires

State Fund is offering a 30-day credit extension to policyholders who are experiencing business disruptions in Plumas County due to the Gold Complex Fire, in Butte and Tehama counties due to the Park Fire, and in Kern County due to the Borel Fire. Governor Gavin Newsom declared states of emergency as the [fires in Northern California](#) have burned nearly 400,000 acres, forcing the evacuation of thousands of residents, destroying homes, and threatening critical infrastructure. The Borel Fire is part of the [SQF Lightning Complex](#), which has burned nearly 90,000 acres.

If you have clients who are unable to report their payroll figures or submit timely payments because of these fires, you or your client can request an extension by contacting [AP at AP contact]. We will do everything we can to accommodate your customers' needs.
